Authors are highly encouraged to seek guidance from Track Chairs prior submitting the paper. We highly encourage authors to formalize this process by sending an abstract to the Track Chairs to receive feedback and guidance.

Formal submission must specify the track that they are intended for. Contributions submitted in English are limited to 12 pages (maximum) according to the paper formatting rules that will be available on the conference website.
