Submission guidelines

Submissions will be evaluated through a standard **blind review** process. Track chairs will select reviewers and ensure anonymity of the review process.

Authors are highly encouraged to seek guidance from Track Chairs prior submitting the paper. We then suggest authors to submit an abstract in order to receive a feedback by the track chairs before the full paper submission.

ITAIS and MCIS have two separate collections for publishing the **conference proceedings** on the **AIS digital library**. For this reason, authors must specify on their submission what collection they are interested in having their paper published on. This information has to be provided by the authors on the EasyChair platform during the submission process.

Furthermore, the best contributions will be published in a Springer volume "Lecture notes in Information Systems and Organization" series, indexed on Scopus. We are also arranging agreements for fast access to journals (some information are already available in the description of specific tracks).
